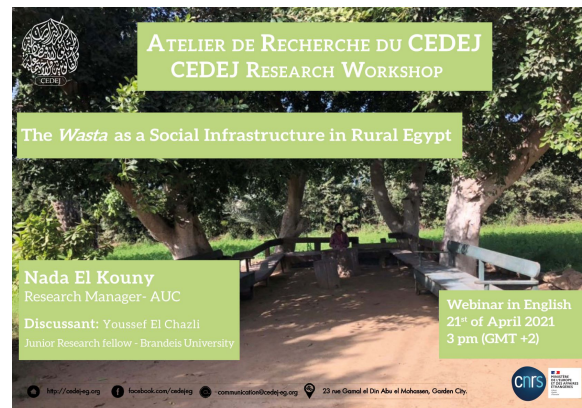
This lecture is part of the upcoming official launch of the Egyptian Census Portal.

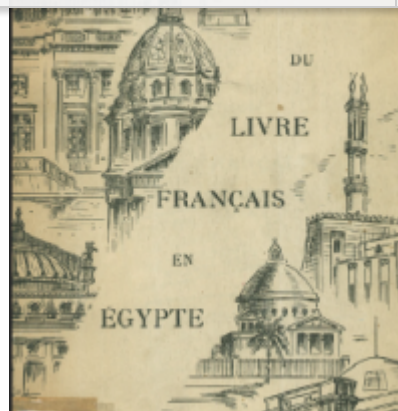
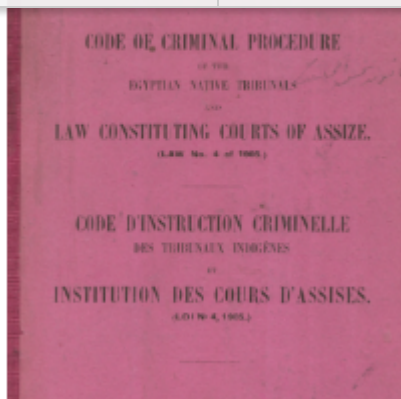
