


## Centre d'études et de documentation économiques, juridiques et sociales



On Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 11am at CEDEJ, Yassine Temlali will present his research: "Between Pan-Arabism and Nationalism: On the Algerian-Egyptian Relations between 1962 and 1965" (in French).

Yassine Temlali is an associate researcher at IREMAM, a joint research unit between the French National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS) and Aix-Marseille University. He holds a PHD in history from Aix-Marseille University. He is the author of *La genèse de la Kabylie. Aux origines de l'affirmation berbère en Algérie 1830-1962* (Paris: La Découverte, 2016; Algiers: Barzakh, 2015) and *Chroniques ciné-littéraires de deux guerres* (Algiers: Barzakh, 2011).

He has contributed to several edited volumes, including the *Routledge Handbook of Francophone Africa (London: Routledge, 2023)* and *Histoire de l'Algérie à la période coloniale 1830-1962* (Paris: La Découverte; Alger: Barzakh, 2012).

His next book, Le problème kabyle dans l'Algérie algérienne (1962-1965) : faits, mirages et mythes fondateurs will be published in 2024. He works currently on the contemporary history of Algeria, including state language policies and the development of Berber affirmation.
