The Arab Political Science Network (APSN), in collaboration with the Center for Economic, Legal, and Social Studies and Documentation (CEDEJ) and the Middle East Studies Program at the American University in Cairo (AUC) invite you to a webinar discussion on "War and the Economy."

The webinar is moderated by Ahmed Morsy and features, Shana Marshall, Omar Dahi, and Joseph Daher. The session will take place via zoom on March 24 at 2 pm EST / 8 pm Cairo.

This session will look at the changing nature of economic activities during conflict and as an outcome of wars. How do regimes, non-state actors and populations survive? What are the new socio-economic dynamics that emerge, and how wars consolidate some of these outcomes? What role does sanctions play and how some regional and international players fuel conflict further? Finally, how the military industrial complex shapes and is influenced by wars, particularly in the US as the biggest producer and exporter of weapons.

This is the third session in a five-part series titled Politics and War in MENA, that brings together researchers and professionals to reflect on, discuss and share expertise using multi-disciplinary perspectives and experiences.
